The **Environmental Statement (ES)**, which reports on the **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)** has been structured to produce a concise, readable and understandable document. The Summary of Assessments of Effects (Volume 1 Chapter 7) are underpinned by detailed supporting information contained in the Technical Appendices (Volume 2). The consultations that established the scope of the Environmental Impact Assessment are reported in Volume 3.
